Discussion questions for students:

Flashlight: How digitally literate do you think you are? Are most of your teachers digitally literate? How could digital literacy enhance your learning experience in the classroom?

Searchlight: Explore a grants database such as <u>Grants.gov</u>. Can you find evidence that there are sources of technology and digital literacy funding for K-12 to innovative tech integration and media literacy projects? Do your school officials know of and pursue these sources?
